Soccer Camp is designed to help you improve your individual skills. Skill sessions will take place in the morning. Group games and individual competitions will be played in the afternoon and evening.

Camp Information

What to bring: Campers should bring personal hygiene items, athletic attire, a good pair of athletic shoes, sweatshirt, bedding, towels, a fan, and a Bible.

What not to bring: Radio, Walkman or tapes, CD player or CD's.

Insurance: All campers must provide their own medical insurance.

Clothing: All campers should bring gym wear (t-shirts and knee-length shorts, no tank tops).

Commuting to Camp: Only those campers who live within 20 miles will be allowed to commute each day to camp.

Meals: Meals will begin with supper on Monday and end with breakfast on Friday.

Registration: A \$40 deposit must accompany each registration and will be applied to the total cost of the camp. This may be refunded upon request, less a \$25 registration fee.

Discount Rate: An early-bird discount will be given to campers who register before June 15, 2007. Campers who would like to attend more than one week of camp may attend the second week at a discounted rate of \$125. The cost for groups of 5 or more will be \$125 per camper. Campers may only take advantage of one discount - the group rate, multiple camp rate, or early-bird rate.

A coach bringing 5 or more campers may attend free of charge. The cost for a coach bringing fewer than 5 campers will be \$60.
